Table 1 shows example outputs from our model. They are derived from our devset with document article ID pairs as follows: document=127e1efe32-b11e606a0c-8f49a2399a-bb4a52f9d9, article ID=1,3; and document=ebfad83ccf-1214df5664-32798c54de-b17e91d958, article id=2. The first example indicates the soundness of complete sentence as answer (beheaded vs she is beheaded). The second example represents the importance of answer synthesizing when answer is not exactly present as span in the document. The third example shows the importance of multi-sentence attention in Context Zoom layer.
