

A Counter Example for Lock-Step Traversal of Multiple Automata




Figure 1: Counter example showing that traversing two automaton in parallel may not find any string in the intersection, even if one exists. The two automaton above have a non-empty intersection (the string ab), but if the search algorithm takes the edge c , then inference will not find any valid string.
