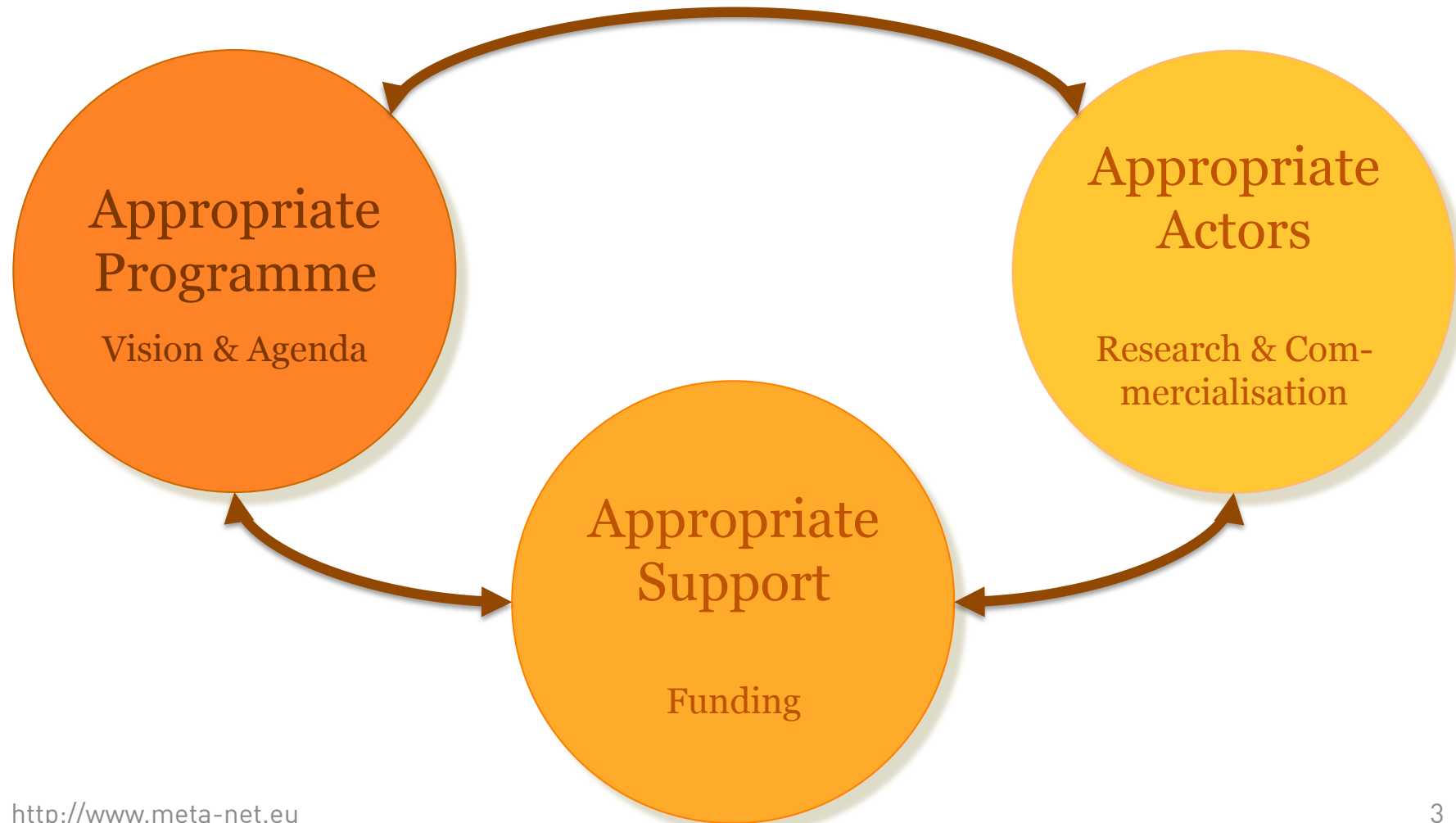

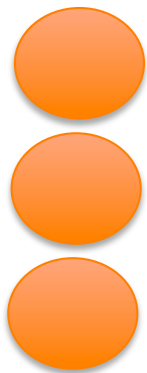
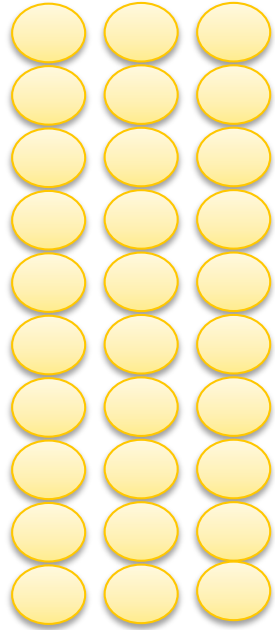

From Visions to the SRA

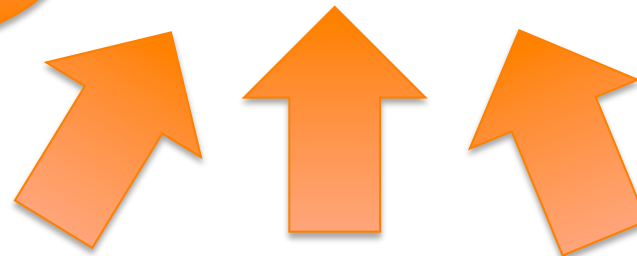
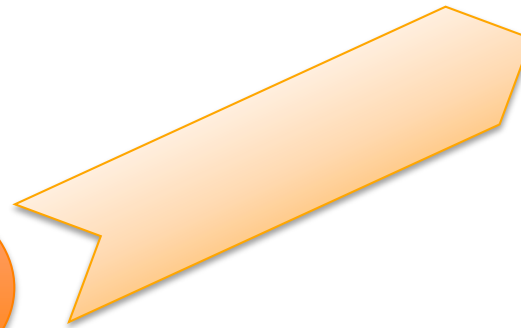
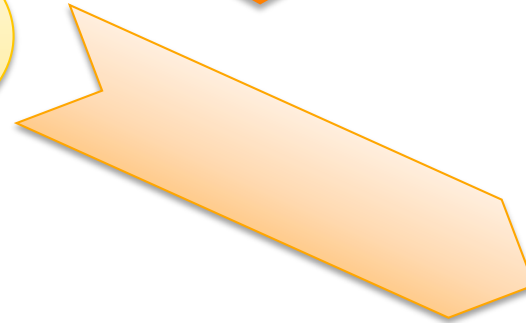

- ❑ **Feedback** to Vision Group results by the Technology Council, by the public at large, across the Vision Groups.
- ❑ The **META Technology Council** is preparing a vision paper, a comprehensive roadmap including individual roadmaps for key socio-economic sectors, light-tower application visions.
- ❑ Finally, a **Strategic Research Agenda** will be presented by the Council (which will reflect the opinions and needs of stakeholders).

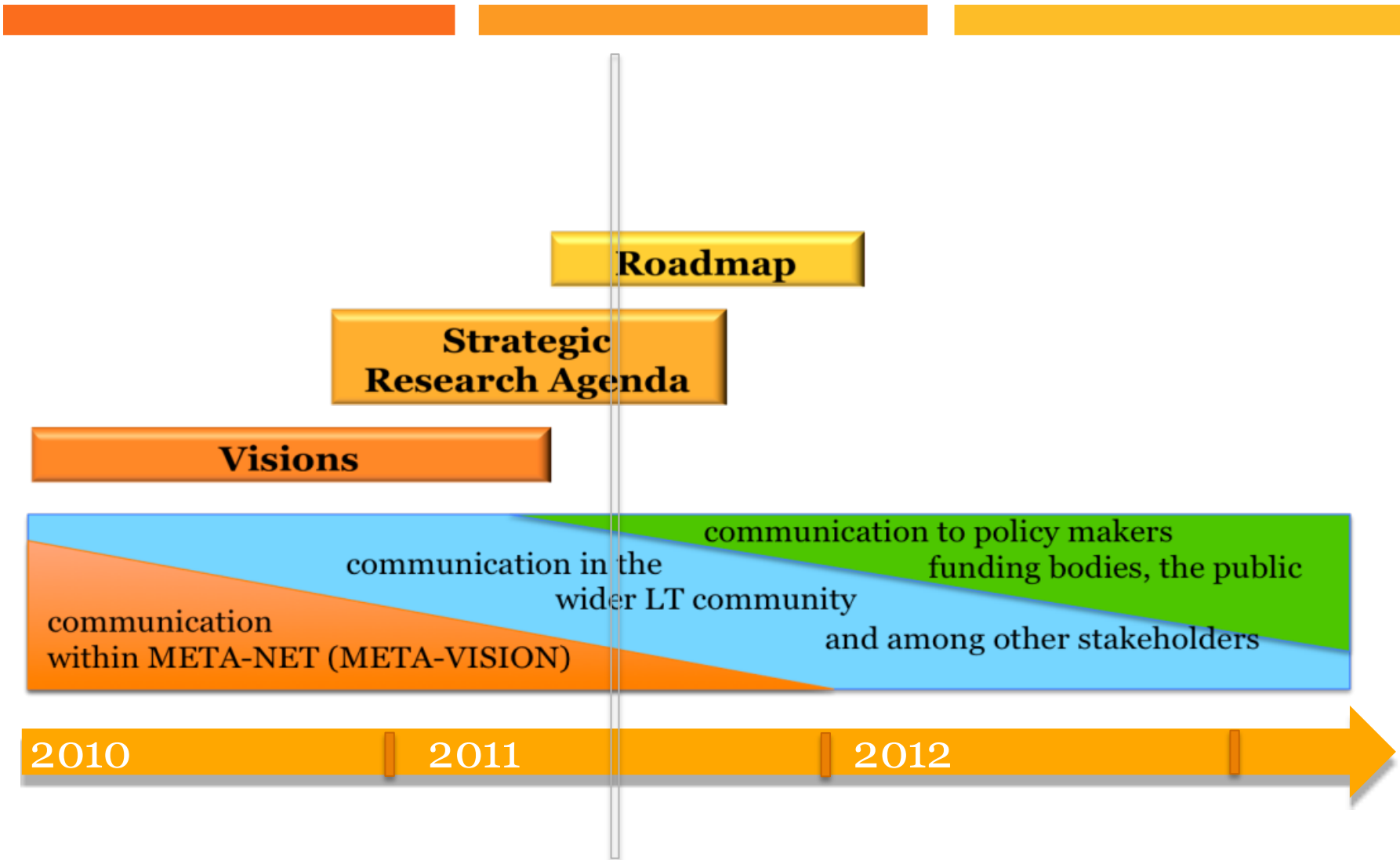
