The International Association for Machine Translation was set up officially in June 1991 with three regional associations to promote and foster the development and active use of machine translation and/or computer assisted translation, and to provide a forum for the exchange of information and ideas among all those interested and involved in this technology. The EAMT is one of the regional associations. The other two are the Japanese Association for Machine Translation (JAMT) and the Association for Machine Translation in the Americas (AMTA).
