## **Stylus: Also from St Petersburg**

At CeBIT '94, PROJECT MT, a St Petersburg company, was marketing its Stylus “family of machine translation system.” PROJECT currently offers English- German- Italian- and French-to-Russian and Russian-to-English and Russian-to-German language pairs. While there may be underlying similarities between Stylus and SILOD, PROJECT offers a slick-looking Windows version, as well as a DOS version, and a “dictionary update utility,” the lack of which is a serious shortcoming with SILOD.

At the Hannover fair, PROJECT was offering Stylus for US\$299 per direction for the DOS version and US\$339 for the Windows version. Bidirectional packages cost respectively US\$399 and US\$439. PROJECT also offers an “aerospace industry” version for US\$799 (both directions). Stylus is also copy-protected.
